PROCUREMENT under LOT 1: FLOODS RESCUE BOATS AND EQUIPMENT

- ✓ Overall value approx. 512.000 euro
- ✓ Successfully Procured:
 - 16 boats (8 infatable and 8 alu) – 2 boats per country including sanitary and medical kit
 - Personal protective equipment for 8 teams /11 members each team (drysuits, boots, helmets, backpack)
 - Management and logistics equipment (tent, heater, computers and GSM, table & chairs, etc)
- ✓ All team will receive the same equipment, with EU/IPA floods logos and national flags



PROCUREMENT under LOT 1: FLOODS RESCUE BOATS AND EQUIPMENT

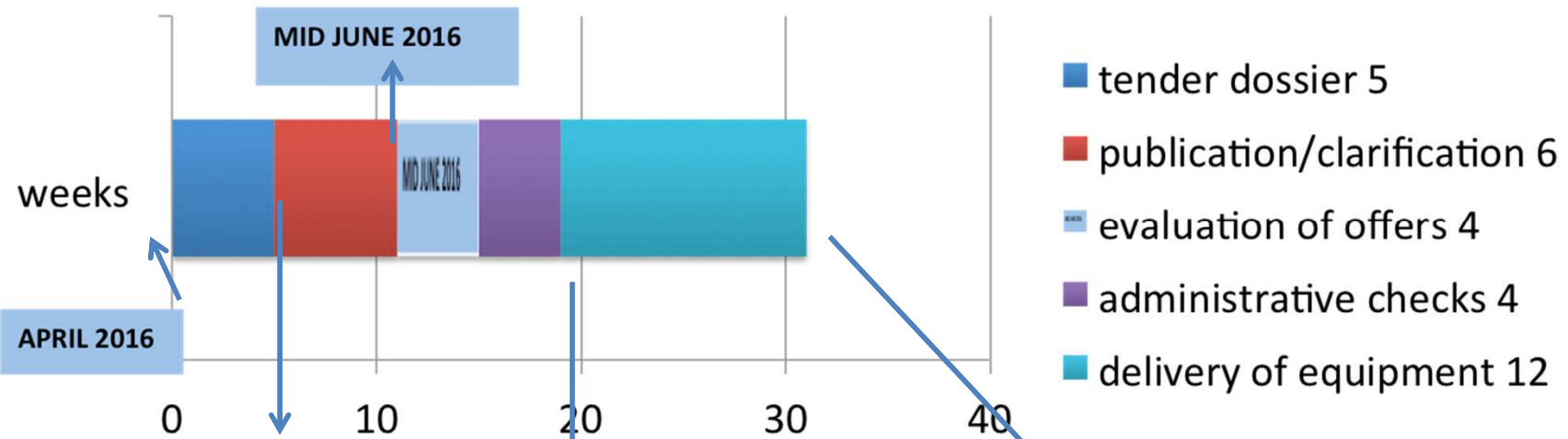
- ✓ Intended delivery 30 March – 15 April
- ✓ Delivery organised in three slots:
 - Boats
 - PPE
 - Management & logistics
- ✓ A draft donation agreement has been shared. Contacts concluded with Croatia, ongoing in Montenegro and Macedonia and Kosovo
- ✓ In order to facilitate customs clearance, delivery information including list of equipment, value and pro-forma invoice will be shared before the delivery

PROCUREMENT under LOT 2: HCP and FC

- ✓ The list of items to be procured shall be agreed these days
 - Official approval of final lists;
 - Confirmation of official owner and end-user of equipment;
 - Pre-acceptance of the donation (incl. tax exemption and exemption of any further financial burden for the Consortium besides the actual cost of equipment);
 - Place of delivery
- ✓ Procurement will be managed by Studiare Sviluppo in accordance with EU public procurement directive:
- ✓ Open procedure – publicity and notice in both EU and Italian journals + publicity via beneficiaries and consortium members
